Find delight in every moment, but do not lose sight of your goal to graduate on time and in good standing.

The following activities are scheduled with you in mind. These special events will help make your senior year one of the most unforgettable years of your life.

Requirements for Graduation

Students must complete all required credits by Monday, May 13, and must participate in the Graduation Rehearsal, Thursday, May 16, to be able to take part in the graduation ceremony, May 18. There are no exceptions to this district policy. Seniors who complete work after May 13, may attend the July, 2013, summer graduation ceremony.

Financial Obligations

All financial obligations should be rectified on or before May 13, 2013. Please be mindful of the obligations for which your student is responsible. At this time, Atlantic Community High School is only accepting cash or money orders to clear obligations. It is imperative to remember that students will not participate in any senior activities until all obligations have been cleared.

Checkout

May 13, 2013 will be the mandatory checkout for seniors from 8:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. Please enter the Media Center by the South East doors only. Students are not to be anywhere on campus except the Media Center. Upon completion of this procedure, caps & gowns will be distributed.

Graduation Rehearsal

Graduation rehearsal will be held at Atlantic High School's Auditorium on Thursday, May 16, 2013 at 1PM. Graduates who must be absent, must have a parent "stand in" or they will not be placed in line for the actual graduation. This rehearsal is mandatory.

Graduation Attire

Be sure the gown is pressed; Females should wear white dresses and comfortable white shoes. Males should wear white shirts, ties, slacks, socks and dark shoes. Athletic shoes are not permitted. Students inappropriately dressed will not be permitted to participate.

Graduation Tickets

Seven tickets will be issued to each graduating senior for family and friends. Admission to graduation will be by ticket only. All children must also have tickets. Tickets will be issued to the students at the conclusion of the 1:00 p.m. graduation rehearsal on May 16, 2013 if the student has no financial obligations. We are urging families who do not need all of their tickets to share with other families.

Commencement

The Graduation Ceremony for the Class of 2013 will be held at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 18, 2013 at the South Florida Fair Grounds. Seniors are to report to the convention center no later than 6:45 a.m.

Behavior

Graduation is a joyous celebration, but it contains serious components that include inspirational messages, speeches, and the official pronouncement that the class has met the graduation requirements. Therefore, it is imperative that proper etiquette is maintained throughout the ceremony.

Graduation Pictures

A professional photographer will take individual pictures of each graduate as he/she exits the stage. Parents and friends may not come on the floor or stage to take pictures or to video during any portion of the ceremony. It is recommended that all pictures of students in caps and gowns be taken before commencement as caps and gowns are collected immediately after the ceremony.

Important Graduation Reminders for Parents

On Saturday, May 18, 2013, the doors to the main floor of the South Florida Fair Grounds will be locked from 7:50 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. as the processional begins. Parents and guests are asked to be at the Fair Grounds no later 7:30 a.m. to ensure that they do not miss any part of the ceremony. Parents and guests are also reminded that the traffic entering the Fair Grounds can be quite heavy just before the ceremony.
